**1| RECYCLED CHIC** Scaffolding boards have been used to create the shelving and table in this scheme. Designed by Compass & Rose, it features off-the-peg painted cabinets, from **£7,000** for a kitchen, British Standard, 020 7870 7688, [britishstandardcupboards.co.uk](http://britishstandardcupboards.co.uk).

**2| MADE IN ITALY** Distressed finishes are given a sophisticated look by mixing raw pine doors with stainless steel. The tall cabinets feature a lead finish from the new Metals collection, from **£36,000**, by Piero Lissoni for Boffi, 020 7590 8910, [boffiuk.com](http://boffiuk.com).

**3| GET SET** Enjoy the contemporary chic of

concrete without its porous, chip-prone traits with a concrete-effect ceramic from Alno, 0113 331 5100, [alnokitchens.co.uk](http://alnokitchens.co.uk). Part of the Alnocera collection, from **£25,000**, it is striking against the dark wood elsewhere in this scheme.

**4| HIGH POLISH** Limestone walls and rope slung pendants add rustic charm to industrial stainless steel and rich wood in this coastal home by US-based Dorothee Junkin Design Studio. Similar bespoke kitchen cabinetry in the UK would cost from around **£25,000**.

**5| MARBLE MARVEL** A strongly veined Statuary marble island and worktop create

bold impact against dark painted wood units in this kitchen, from **£40,000**, by Smallbone of Devizes, 020 7589 5998, [smallbone.co.uk](http://smallbone.co.uk).

**6| ROUGH AND SMOOTH** Bespoke concrete surfaces provide a textural contrast with Planar Cream gloss units, from **£6,200**, by Magnet, 01325 469441, [magnet.co.uk](http://magnet.co.uk), in this kitchen extension by Coupdeville Architects.

**7| RICH MIX** Velvety soft matt lacquers are perfect for creating blocks of colour. This Topaz kitchen in Nero Super Matt, from **£10,000**, Rational, [rational.de/en](http://rational.de/en), is given a warm lift with copper-look handles and wood worktops.
